The Legacy Landscapes program helps cow-calf grazing operations track and improve their productivity, efficiency, and long-term resilience through better livestock management and grazing decisions. Participating producers are supported with:

How does the Legacy Landscapes program work?

Producers initially meet with a local NatGLC advisor to assess their operation, identify practices and create a tailored plan. Producers receive funding annually throughout the entire program to implement those practices.

To track ranch improvements, participants will use a ranch management software (like AgriWebb)* to collect basic records throughout the program. At the start and then once annually, producers will submit these records through the Legacy Landscapes Program Hub in AgriWebb. Technical advisors will assist with the record submission to make the process as simple as possible.

The participant's permissioned and submitted data will enable AllTech to report on sustainability outcomes.**

*AgriWebb is the preferred software for Legacy Landscapes. When used, your daily ranch records flow straight into the Legacy Landscapes Program Hub, making annual data submissions quick and easy. With other platforms, manual data entry is required.

****Your data, your control. Always.**

All records captured in AgriWebb are fully owned by the rancher. Once annually, producers will permission specific records to be shared through the Legacy Landscapes Program Hub. Only after this approval are records automatically shared with AllTech for sustainability outcomes reporting.

Records you'll submit through the Legacy Landscapes Program Hub

NatGLC team members will help you collect and submit 2-3 years of baseline data at the beginning of the program.

Category	Information to report	Required data points
Mapping	Where is your ranch?	Create a ranch map
Livestock	No. of head by age class	- Starting number of Head - Number of births - Number of deaths - Purchases (financial details not required) - Sales (financial details not required)
	Starting weights	Weight (measured or estimated averages using birth/purchases and sale weights)
	End weights	Sale weight (even if from sale barn)
	Terminal Vs Non-terminal	Are these animals being sold to slaughter? Terminal: feeder calves, culled breeding stock Non-terminal: breeding stock, replacement heifers
	Days in age class	- Weaning, Age in / Age out - Dates when animals enter/leave operation
	Feed	- What was fed? - How much was fed? - When was it fed?
Feed crops (if relevant)	Fertilizer Usage	- Location - What fertilizer was used? - How was it applied and how much? - When was it applied?
	Planting	- Location - What seed was sown? - At what rate? - When did seeding happen?
	Harvest	- Location - What was harvested? - How much was harvested? - When was it harvested?
	Tillage	Tillage Records - When did tilling happen? - Depth of tillage?
	Irrigation	Irrigation Records - When was it irrigated? - How much was it irrigated?
